Zyxel Group’s Climate Targets Approved by SBTi

Zyxel Group’s greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction targets have been officially approved by the **Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi)**, confirming that the company’s decarbonization goals are aligned with the 1.5°C pathway set forth by the Paris Agreement.



This milestone underscores Zyxel’s commitment to low-carbon transformation and to driving climate action across its value chain for long-term environmental sustainability.

Under the approved near-term targets, Zyxel Group commits to reducing absolute Scope 1 and Scope 2 GHG emissions by **42% by 2030**, using **2021** as the base year. Additionally, the company aims to reduce absolute Scope 3 emissions by **58.8% by 2034**, from a **2023** base year. For the long term, Zyxel targets **net-zero emissions across Scopes 1, 2, and 3 by 2050**. [\(Read more\)](#)

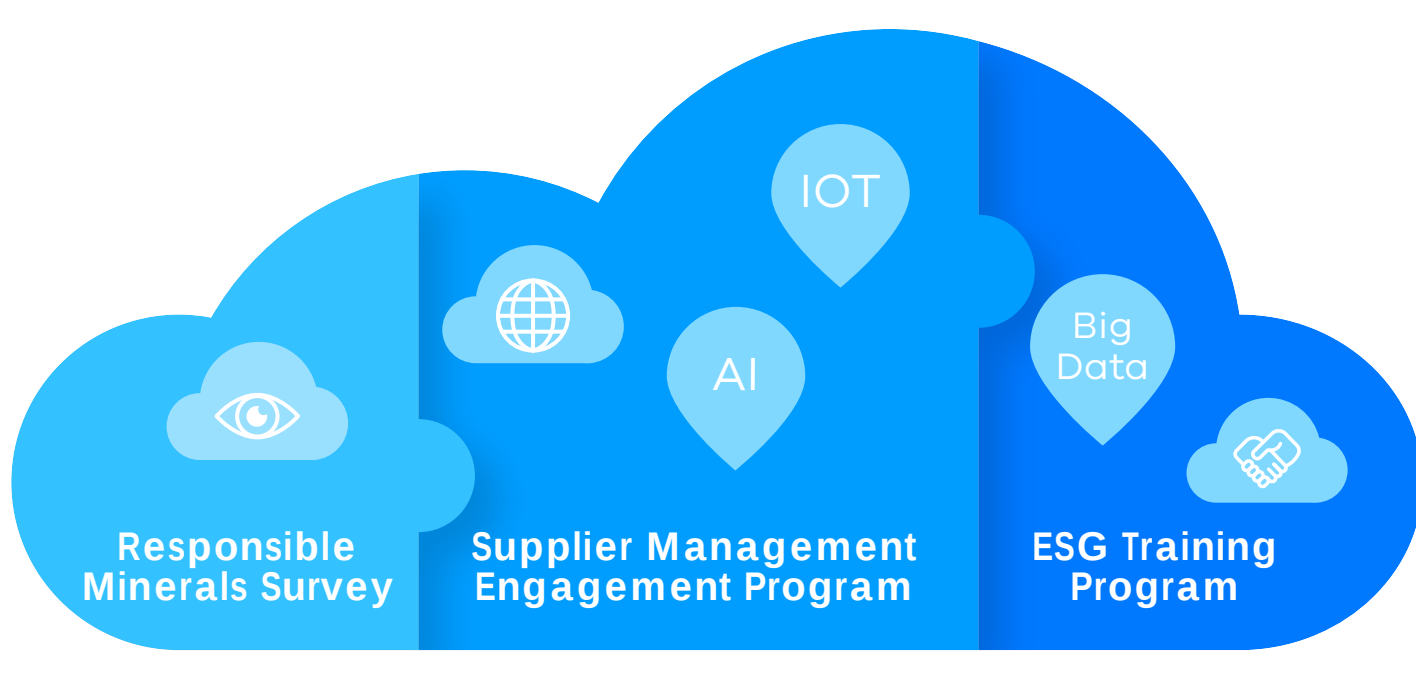


About SBTi (Science Based Targets initiative):
